#### **Summer Reading Activities for Future Third Graders**

- 2. Choose one activity to complete for each book.
- 3. Be creative with the materials you will use as: markers, paints, construction paper, craft supplies, recycled items, etc.
- 4. You can use your own drawings, clip art, or internet pictures. Any hand-drawn-illustrations should always be completed in color.
- 5. Spelling and grammar count on all projects!
- 6. You can print or type your project, BUT all information should be written in your own words. NO PLAGIARISM
- 7. All book projects must be dated, measure  $8^{-1}/_2 \times 11$ , contain the title of the book and author's name.

Create a tri-fold for your nonfiction text. Tri-fold should include:  illustrations with captions glossary (minimum 3 words) Did you know facts? (5 facts) Remember to include title/author	Create a timeline of the book. Your timeline must include at least 10 events with descriptions in order from beginning to end of the story along with pictures to represent each event.				
Informational Text  Write a poem about the idea, topic, or information presented in your book.	Literary Text  Create a collage around central idea or theme in the book. For example: friendship, courage, family, etc.  Write a half page description of the central idea or theme presented in the collage.				
Informational/Literary Text  Make a poster 8 $^{1}/_{2}$ x 11 advertising your book so someone else will want to read it. Write a half page explanation why someone will want to read it.	Informational/Literary Text  You are the reporter. Write a front-page news story or a report live from the scene.





#### Summer Tips for Success with Reflex!


Dear Parents/Guardians,
