



Dear Advanced Academics Student,

Select <u>one</u> of the projects below to demonstrate in a creative manner your understanding of <u>one</u> of the books you read. The project is to show a creation made by the student and this assignment will be <u>graded based on the student's creativity</u>. Projects will be graded based on spelling, grammar, punctuation, effort, organization, creativity, and originality. <u>All</u> <u>projects are due Thursday, August 17, 2023</u>. Please be ready to <u>present your project on</u> <u>Thursday, August 17, 2023</u> to your new class. <u>No late projects will be accepted!</u>

Write a <u>song</u>, <u>poem</u>, <u>or rap</u> song that describes a species of ocean animals, tree, plant, or flower. You must include the name, a description of the item, why this item is so important, where it can be located, and how this item helps people and our Earth. You can publish your song, poem, or rap on a sheet of paper or use a scrapbook page up to 12 X 12. Decorate your masterpiece. Create a <u>magazine cover</u> page using one of these titles:

<u>Ocean Species of the Year,</u> <u>Historical Figure of Florida,</u> <u>Plant of the Year,</u> <u>Tree of the Year,</u>

Flower of the Year.

Draw a picture of the winning item. Write a title and headings to make a cover page. Make sure the title and the headings describe the reasons why this item won the award of the year. Decorate the cover. The magazine cover page must be the size of a sheet of paper, 8 1/2 X 11.

Used recycled materials found at home to create a small 3D model of an ocean animal, tree, plant, or flower. Write on an index card the following: name of the animal, tree, plant, or flower, the reason why this item is important, and explain how people can use this animal. tree, plant, or flower. Glue the index card to the bottom of your 3D model. Model can be up to 12 X 12.
