A Person of the Year

Bookmark. Write a title that describes the main character of the story. Draw and color a picture of the main character and include a drawing of where the story takes place. Decorate the bookmark and add a ribbon or tassel to it. Your project can be up to 2in. X 7in. Write your name on the back of the bookmark.

A Book Cube project. Use a cube-size tissue box and decorate it with pictures that describe the story. On one side, draw a picture of the characters; on the other side, draw a picture about the setting; on the third side, draw a picture about the problem of the story; and on the last side, draw a picture of the solution of the story. Write a caption under each drawing or picture. Write your name on the bottom of the cube.

Use recycled materials found at home to create a small 3D model of a vehicle that can travel in the air, ground, or water. Write on an index card the following: name of the vehicle, the reason why this object is important, and explain how people can use it. Glue the index card to the bottom of your 3D model. Model can be up to 12in. X 12in. Write your name on the bottom of the model and on the back of the index card.


