Write a title and headings to make a cover page. Make sure the title and the headings describe the reasons why this item won the award of the year. Decorate the cover. The magazine cover page must be the size of a sheet of paper, 8 ½ X 11.</p>	<p>Used recycled materials found at home to <u>create a small 3D model</u> of an ocean animal, tree, plant, or flower. 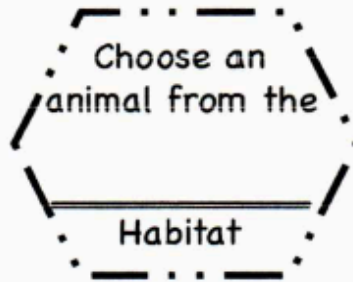
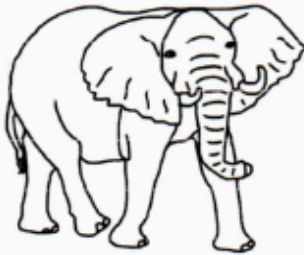


HABITAT PROJECT

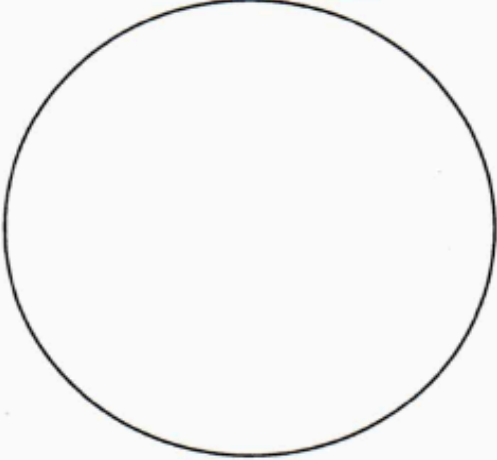

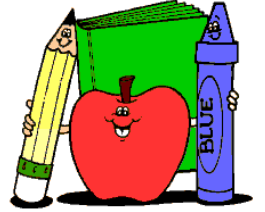
